



CARROLL COLLEGE UNIFORM

PERSONAL PRESENTATION

The appearance and behaviour of our students speaks of their pride in the College. All students are expected to follow the College uniform policy.

STUDENT APPEARANCE

- The College policy is that hair is to be clean, neat and tidy at all times.
- Hair is to be off the face ie. fastened back with slides or ties, with longer hair tied back at all times.
- Long sleeved shirts cannot be worn underneath College shirts and sports polos.
- Coloured hair must remain within the limits of the natural hair range.
- Dreadlocks are not considered acceptable nor appropriate and are therefore not permitted at the College.
- Students are to be clean-shaven unless religious or medical reasons necessitate otherwise. Students who do not follow this may be asked to shave at the College.
- Mullets, mohawks and patterned shaving are not permitted as hairstyles.
- Fake nails and eyelash extensions are not permitted.
- Tattoos must be covered at all times.

Principal's discretion applies in all cases.

JEWELLERY

College uniform permits the following jewellery:

- wristwatch
- signet ring
- chain with religious medal or cross
- earrings (sleepers or studs with no more than two earrings in either or both ears).
- Facial piercing jewellery is not permitted. A clear, unobtrusive plastic stud will be permitted if necessary.
- Earrings may be required to be covered in PE or sport periods.
- Make-up or nail polish is not acceptable and must be removed.

SHOES

- Shoes are to be black leather lace up school shoes (Canvas/fabric shoes, boots, ballet or mary jane style shoes are not permitted at any time). Heel must not exceed 4cm. (See example below for permitted or not footwear)
- During practical subjects (PDHPE, Sport) students must wear appropriate sports shoes. (See example below for permitted or not footwear)
- Students who have TAS timetabled on the same day as a practical PDHPE lesson must bring their black leather school shoes to school to wear for their TAS lesson.

WHEN OUT OF UNIFORM

Students who present to the College out of uniform (unexplained) on the first and second occasion will receive an AM detention, this includes students who wear their PE uniform on non-authorised days. Those who present to the College a third time with incorrect uniform attire will be exited to the Hub and contact will be made home.

OUT OF UNIFORM DAYS

Occasionally, students will have the opportunity to wear casual clothing. The requirement on these days is that students dress suitably for the school setting eg. tights and crop tops are not permitted.

UNIFORM CHANGE-OVER DATES

The Summer Uniform is to be worn Term 1 and Term 4, unless otherwise directed by the Principal or Assistant Principal. The Winter Uniform is to be worn Term 2 and Term 3, unless otherwise directed by the Principal or Assistant Principal.

It is normal practice that the summer uniform is worn for the first 3-5 weeks into Term 2 until the weather cools down. The college provides ample notice of the winter uniform changeover date.

PURCHASING UNIFORMS

The Clothing Pool offers second hand uniforms as well as the sports uniform, jackets and jerseys. Families can purchase uniforms locally in Batemans Bay through Hip Pocket Workwear, Stitches or Lowes.

SUNSMART POLICY

The College follows the Catholic Education Sunsmart Policy.

Students are reminded that it is College policy that they are expected to protect themselves from the harmful UV rays of the sun.

- Slip** Students are required to wear the College uniform or sports uniform for all activities.
Slop Sunblock (50+) is provided by the College for outdoor activities.
Slap Students are urged to wear the College hat or cap when involved in outdoor activities.

HEADWEAR

- Students are to wear the College cap or bucket hat while participating in any outdoor sporting activity. The College hat is also to be worn at AM and PM breaks during Terms 1 and 4. It is recommended that protective sunscreen also be worn at these times.

GIRLS UNIFORM (Years 7 – 10)

SUMMER

- Teal and white checked dress – length should be no higher than 4 cm above the knee
- Plain white socks worn above the ankle
- Shoes are to be black leather lace up school shoes (Canvas/fabric shoes, boots, ballet or mary jane style shoes are not permitted at any time). Heel must not exceed 4cm. (See example below for permitted or not footwear)
- College woollen jumper or jersey
- College cap or bucket hat
- Black jacket (as required)

WINTER

- White College shirt, long or short sleeved (no long sleeve shirts permitted underneath)
- College Tartan skirt (skirt length should be no higher than 4 cm above the knee) or College black trousers
- College woollen jumper or jersey
- Black stockings or plain white socks worn above the ankle
- Shoes are to be black leather lace up school shoes (Canvas/fabric shoes, boots, ballet or mary jane style shoes are not permitted at any time). Heel must not exceed 4cm. (See example below for permitted or not footwear)
- Black jacket (as required)

BOYS UNIFORM (Years 7 – 10)

SUMMER AND WINTER

- Dark grey College shorts or trousers (shorts are permitted all year round)
- College white shirt (long sleeve or short sleeve)
- College woollen jumper or jersey
- Plain Dark grey socks
- Shoes are to be black leather lace up school shoes (Canvas/fabric shoes, boots are not permitted at any time). Heel must not exceed 4cm. (See example below for permitted or not footwear)
- Black jacket (as required)

SPORTS AND PE UNIFORM – GIRLS AND BOYS (Years 7 – 12)

The PE uniform is to be worn on sport days and PE periods only

- College tracksuit pants or College shorts (worn at appropriate length)
- College sports polo
- Plain white sports socks (no logo)
- College jersey
- Appropriate sports shoes (See example below for permitted or not footwear)
- Black jacket (as required)

SENIOR GIRLS UNIFORM (Years 11 – 12)

SUMMER AND WINTER

- College Senior skirt (skirt length should be no higher than 4 cm above the knee) or College Black trousers
- White College shirt, long or short sleeved (no long sleeve shirts permitted underneath)
- Plain white socks worn above the ankle
- Shoes are to be black leather lace up school shoes (Canvas/fabric shoes, boots are not permitted at any time). Heel must not exceed 4cm. (See example below for permitted or not footwear)
- College woollen jumper or jersey
- College blazer (optional)

SENIOR BOYS UNIFORM (Years 11 – 12)

SUMMER

- Taupe shorts
- College white shirt
- College woollen jumper or jersey
- Plain dark grey socks
- Shoes are to be black leather lace up school shoes (Canvas/fabric shoes, boots are not permitted at any time). Heel must not exceed 4cm. (See example below for permitted or not footwear)

WINTER

- Taupe trousers
- College long sleeved white shirt
- College tie
- College woollen jumper or jersey
- Plain dark grey socks
- College blazer (optional)
- Shoes are to be black leather lace up school shoes (Canvas/fabric shoes, boots are not permitted at any time). Heel must not exceed 4cm. (See example below for permitted or not footwear)

OPTIONAL EXTRAS TO UNIFORMS FOR ALL STUDENTS

- College crested beanie and scarf
- College black Jacket
- College blazer
- It is recommended that parents consider the option of an ergonomically designed backpack.



School Shoes @ Carroll College

Students must wear black leather, lace-up shoes.
No ballet, or mary-jane style. No boots or canvas/fabric shoes.
Heel must be no higher than 4cm.







Sport Shoes @ Carroll College

Students must wear appropriate runners for practical lessons.
Flat soled shoes such as skate shoes, court shoes and casual shoes are not permitted.
